

# Year 3 Homework Project

## Rainforests

Date set: Wednesday 7th November

Date due: **Wednesday 12th December**

This term's topic is Rainforests. We will be looking at maps to see where in the world the rainforests can be found as well as studying the different animals which live there.

For your homework project we would like you to choose one of the layers of a tropical rainforest to research: forest floor, understory, canopy or emergent layer.

We would like you to make your chosen layer in a shoe box (or similar sized box).

Here are some ideas for how to decorate your shoe box:

- Paint the background to look like your chosen layer
- Make 3D plants. You can use cardboard tubes, art straws, string for vines, tissue paper or paper sponge painted green
- You could draw, colour or paint animals to cut out and stick into your rainforest

We hope that we get lots of projects for each layer so we can build whole rainforests like the one in the picture.
